We strive to enrich the well-being of families and caregivers by offering a healthy and safe environment where their loved ones may thrive.



PROVIDING COMMUNITY

At The Exceptional Foundation, we offer activities and experiences that our participants might not find anywhere else, especially after they age out of school programs and resources. Through our programs, adult participants can attend prom, travel locally and nationally for Special Olympics competitions, and join clubs designed to introduce them to a new kind of exercise or special interest. Youth participants go to summer and after-school camps, which include field trips around the greater Birmingham area, and make friends through programs designed for them. At the center of our organization is our community – an engaging and fun place that celebrates each participant's individual talents, goals, and personalities as well as the friendships made throughout our programs.

9TH ANNUAL DINNERTAINMENT


